The students of KENNEDY HIGH the global school participated and brought laurels in the various events organized by Sakshi TV channel in the Academic Year 2018-19. The two major events conducted by the Sakshi TV group were, the Sakshi Math Bee and the Sakshi Spell Bee Championship. Around 2000 students from both CBSE and Cambridge wing participated in these events. These events were state level events in which, over 15,000 students across various schools throughout Telangana participated. The students left no stone unturned to prove their mettle.

In the Math Bee event 6 students across various categories made it to the final round. Kanuv Singhal of class IV-E bagged the first prize, a cash reward of Rs. 15,000/- and Likith Jalli of class II-C won the second prize, a cash reward of Rs. 10,000/- respectively.

In the spell bee event 14 students across the 4 categories made it to the final round. Atharv Mishra of class II-B bagged the first prize, a cash reward of Rs. 15,000/- in category 1, Anush Gudimetla of class IV-C, stood second with a cash reward of Rs. 10,000/-, Himaja .D of class IV-F stood third with a cash reward of Rs. 5,000/- in category 2 and Adyasha Acharya of class VII-I stood third with a cash reward of Rs. 5,000/- in category 3 respectively.

The semi-finals of Sakshi Spell Bee was also conducted in the school premises on 30 December 2018, where 700 students across Telangana participated and few made it to the finals.

**The CCMB Young Innovator's program** was held during the 2nd and 3rd weeks of January 2019. Out of 131 participants from various regions and schools, Harshith Jay Surya Sai Ganji of class VIII-I along with 23 other students got selected for this program. He received first-hand experience with scientist Dr. Harsha Gupta, an Indian Seismologist, who was his guide and judge. He performed many activities including the DNA isolation from blood and bacteria culture, preparation of permanent slides, making of automatic street lamps, research on bio informatics etc. He also visited the zebra fish facility, instrumentation facility, AIC (Atal Incubatin Centre) etc. The interactive sessions with various scientists were very inspirational.

**INTELLIGem-TCSion FINANCE OLYMPIAD:** TCSion IntelliGem Financial Literacy powered by Tata Trusts and NSE Academy was an initiative to promote Financial Literacy among students to make them familiar with useful concepts of Finance and Economics. 124 students from our school registered and participated in the preliminary round of the Financial Literacy Quiz held at our school. Of this, 107 qualified for the online test in the second round held at Alwal, Hyderabad. 18 of our students received Bronze medals and certificates of distinction for their commendable performance in the second round. 4 students, Sumanth Reddy Mudiya of class IX-E, Shikhar Sinha of class IX-I, Suvam Mishra of class VII-I, Mohammed Sirajuddin of class VIII-I qualified for the finals held at Mumbai on 25 and 26 January 2019. It was an enriching experience for our students there to be quizzed by the famous Quiz master of India 'Pickbrain Giri'. The qualifiers received a cheque of Rs. 25,000/- and goodies worth Rs. 10,000 along with Silver medals and certificates for their participation in Mumbai. All the other students were given participation certificates and certificates of excellence respectively.



**ONE DAY TRAINING PROGRAMME CBP ON 'GENDER SENSITIVITY WORKSHOP':** A workshop at KENNEDY HIGH the global school on Gender Sensitivity was conducted as a part of CBSE, COE Kakinada, Capacity Building Program. 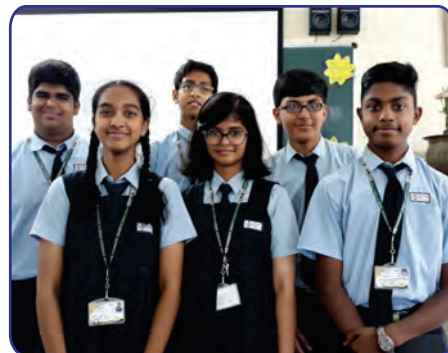

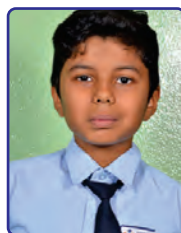
